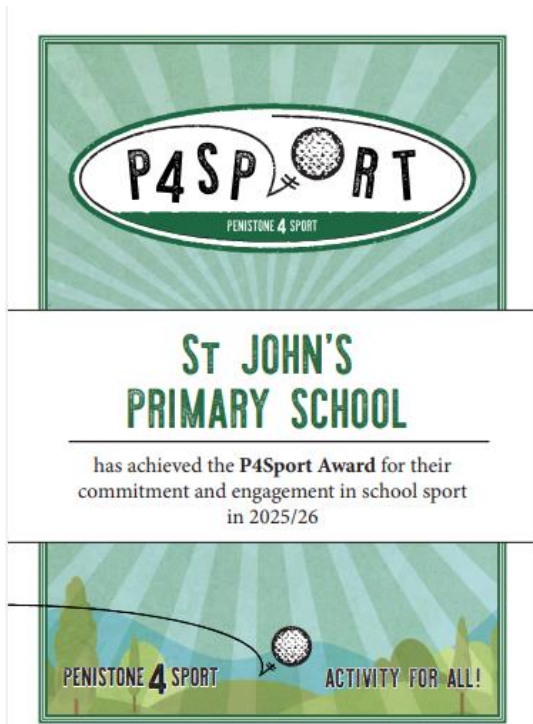
Activity/Action	Impact
Activities organised by School Games organiser network £510	Children had the opportunity to access bespoke training at a sports venue developing their interests and experiences.

External coaching staff £4698	Children had access to a range of sporting disciplines with trained coaches to develop their knowledge, skills and enthusiasm for the different sports.
